ENSURE WOMEN'S SECURITY IN TRANSPORT SYSTEMS

RECOGNIZE sexual harassment and genderbased violence as criminal offences and develop reliable reporting mechanisms

DESIGN open public areas with visibility, lighting and CCTV systems at stations

TRAIN public transport staff to deal with sexual harassment situations

ENSURE a greater and gendermixed staff presence at stations and in vehicles **EVALUATE** the need for women and children-only services in public transport and ride hailing services

PROVIDE information on public transport schedules to avoid long waiting time

ROLL-OUT «on demand bus stop» at night and early morning to reduce walking distances

INCLUDE security requirements in tendering documents and bonuspenalty clauses in contracts with operators
